



# SPORTS PROCEDURES

## 2018-2019

- A. Sport/Chair/AD Liaison:** Women's Basketball D1/Tina Wilson/TBA
- B. Division:** Division 1
- C. District:** District K
- D. Regions Involved:** Region 11 and 16
- E. Regional Tournament Dates:** March 1st and 3rd, 2019
  - 1. Game Times:**
    - i. Friday -5:00PM (1 vs. 4/5) & 7:00 (2 vs. 3/6)
    - ii. Sunday – 3:30PM
  - 2. 30 minute minimum warmup time between games at regional tournament.
- F. Regional Tournament Sites(s):** Lincoln University, Jefferson City, MO
- G. Regional Tournament Cut-off Dates:** March 3rd, 2019
- H. All Region Team Selection:**
  - 1. 10 individuals will be named to the first team all-region team and any other individual receiving a vote will be named to the second team all-region team.
  - 2. First team members will receive a plaque and the second team members will receive a certificate. Should a tie take place in the fifth spot, those tied will be awarded to the first team.
  - 3. Coaches may nominate any number of players from their roster.
  - 4. Coaches will submit nominations on the Region Nomination Form that is located on the Region 16 website, prior to the first round of the Region championship.
  - 5. Players will be ranked in order of preference, one-five, with one being the highest.
  - 6. Coaches may not vote for their own players and ballots must be signed before being turned in to the AD liaison before the final four. Ballots will only be valid if signed and five players have been selected.
  - 7. The top vote getter for Region XVI will be named the Region player of the year and will be recognized, the top freshman vote getter will be recognized as the Freshman of the Year for Region 16.
  - 8. First team All-Region members will be nominated for All-American status. All necessary support material must be submitted to the Regional Director.
- I. Selection of Coach of the Year** will be voted on before the Region XVI Tournament, in case of a tie, there will be a revote.

- M. National Tournament Dates:** March 18-23, 2019

2. Region tournament officials will be hired by the Region Assignor.

**P. Region Tournament:**

1. **Region Play:** Discussed playing each team 3 times in a home and away/flipping home and away each year for the 3<sup>rd</sup> game.
2. **Regional Tournament Seeding:**
  - i. Region record. For ties involving two teams starting with the lower seed.
  - ii. Results of head to head competition during the regular season
  - iii. Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in the case of a tie for the championship, the next highest position in the regular season standings) continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group, rather than performance against the individual tied teams.
  - iv. A comparison of the tied teams' Region-only road record.
  - v. Winning percentage against non-region D1 opponents/Nationally ranked throughout the year starting the first December poll.
  - vi. Coin toss with AD liaison and women's region director starting with the lower seed.
3. **For ties involving more than two teams:**
  - i. Results of head to head competition during the regular season among the tied teams (mini round-robin)
  - ii. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied teams' record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings continuing down through the standings and eliminating inferior records until one team gains an advantage. When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group, rather than performance against the individual tied teams
  - iii. If more than two teams are still tied, a comparison of the tied teams region only road record
  - iv. Record against common non-region D1 opponents/Nationally ranked throughout the year starting the first December poll.
  - v. Winning percentage against non-region D1 opponents, even if the number of games played is unequal the highest winning percentage shall prevail. In the case of tied percentages, the following shall apply: 2-0 is better than 1-0; 0-1 is better than 0-2.
  - vi. If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie breaking procedures will be applied.
  - vii. Coin toss with AD liaison and women's region director starting with the lower seed.
4. **Film Exchange**
  - i. All region 16 must comply with sharing of game films via Krossover.
  - ii. Failure to comply with this rule, will result in the following:
    1. 1st offense, a letter of reprimand to the AD

2. 2nd offense, a letter of reprimand to the President and AD
3. 3rd offense results in a fine of \$500.
